TEACHER'S QUICK GUIDE

PLAYING THE GAME

From the main screen of **Study Hall 101[®] – Demo Version**, click **Choose your subject**, choose **Study Library**, select **7th Grade History–Alamo-Demo**, & click **OK**. From the main menu, click **Chapter 1**.

ENTERING INFORMATION

Please Note: This Demo Version does not allow information to be saved in the Study Editor. However, by following the steps below, you can learn how this process works in the full version of **Study Hall 101[®]**.

From the main screen, click **Study Editor**, enter the password (the password throughout the game is “iamsure”), and click **OK**. Enter the Grade, Subject, Teacher and Chapter Name. (Regarding “Teacher”, type “all teachers” if information is applicable to all teachers.) The remaining identifying information is optional.

Under ‘Keyword’, type in the first fact to learn. Type in the ‘Long Description’. Type in the ‘Short Description’. (If a fact doesn’t have a long description, leave ‘Long Description’ blank.) All 24 rows must be filled. All key words must be unique.

Series Questions (Optional): Type a short version of the question (ex: “Three parts of an atom :”); then type in either 3 or 4 correct answers and 3 or 4 wrong answers.

Entering Info for the Next Chapter: Advance to the next screen by clicking the ‘up’ arrow next to the ‘Screen’ window (above ‘Keyword’). Put in a new chapter name.

Adding Additional Chapters to Existing Study Files: From the main screen, click **Study Editor**, enter the password, click **Open**, find the file to which you will add the information, and click **OK**. Advance to the needed screen by clicking the ‘up’ arrow next to the ‘Screen’ window.

PROOFS, PRACTICE TESTS & FLASHCARDS

Printing Proofs: From the main screen, click **Choose your subject**, choose **Study Library**, select the Demo file, then click **OK**. Next, click on **Worksheets** and select ‘Proof Sheet’. Enter the password and then click **Chapter 1** to proof it.

Printing Practice Tests:

From the main screen, click **Choose your subject**, choose **Study Library**, select the Demo file, then click **OK**. Next, click on **Worksheets** and select the test version you want (either ‘Matching x 4’, ‘Matching x 6’ or ‘Fill-in-the-blanks’), enter the password and then choose **Chapter 1**.

Printing Flashcards:

From the main screen, click **Choose your subject**, choose **Study Library**, select the Demo file, then click **OK**. Click on **Worksheets**, select ‘Flashcards’, then enter the password and choose **Chapter 1**.

Choose **Black & White Flashcards**. An ‘Output Options’ box appears; click **OK** to preview the information. Click on the printer icon in the top left corner of the toolbar and then click **OK**. The first side of the cards will print. Reinsert the sheets to print the back of the flashcards. You will see another ‘Output Options’ box. Click **OK** to print.

USING A SCREEN READER

Download and install the free version of **Power Text to Speech Reader** from www.1speechsoft.com. Click “download”, then you can choose either the .exe file or the .zip file. This will be the trial version, which only allows it to read 1,000 characters each time it opens. However, it works great for **Study Hall 101[®]**, which never reaches the maximum number of characters. Once installed, open **Power Text to Speech Reader**, and under options, make sure “Watch Clipboard Changed” is checked and change “Ignore Clipboard Text Less Than” to “1”. Also, **deselect** “Ignore Clipboard Updates” and “Prompt to Copy from Clipboard”. You will also want to disable the alarm. Choose the voice, pitch, and speed; then minimize the program. Open **Study Hall 101[®]** and begin the program. On each Learning Screen, you can click on the **Say** button, click on a text box, and then click on the **Say** button again to have the text read aloud.
